Make your own coffee house table ensemble using Designer's Gallery® and LetterWorks™

6.25" x 10.25" hoop For Ellageo

4" x 4" hoop

Palette software

Set of placemats

Set of napkins

½ yard linen

Various colors of embroidery thread

Designer's Gallery® Studio

LetterWorks™

SizeWorks™

ColorWorks®

Water-soluble stabilizer

Machine embroidery spray adhesive

18" x 20" piece of natural or tan linen fabric

Cut-away stabilizer for the large Ellageo hoop

Instructions:

Construction of Blocks:

1. Using the palette system load design number 5 from card 54 to your computer, writing down the location of the file as you save it.
2. Open Designer's Gallery® and select the folder where you saved the design.
3. Select the design and go to tools, select SizeWorks™ and resize the design to 1" x 1 7/8".
4. Save the design and exit out of SizeWorks™.
5. With the design still selected, go to tools and select LetterWorks™.
6. Type in Coffee House using the classic script font.
7. Move, size and arrange the words centered underneath the teacup design. The design should be approximately 1 3/4" x 3".
8. Save the design and exit LetterWorks™.
9. Drag and drop the design into the same location as the original teacup design, saving the edited design.
10. Save the design to a floppy or write it to a card for use with the machine.
11. Hoop the water-soluble stabilizer in the 4" x 4" hoop.
12. Lightly spray the stabilizer with the spray adhesive and position one napkin corner on the hoop.
13. Embroider the design.
14. Remove the design from the hoop and remove excess stabilizer.
15. Repeat for the remaining napkin.

For the Towel:

1. Open Designer's Gallery® and select the edited design for the napkins.
2. Open SizeWorks™ and resize the design to approximately 2 1/4" x 3 3/4".
3. Hoop the stabilizer the same as with the napkins, centering the towel in the hoop.

For the Placemats:

1. Open Designer's Gallery®.
2. Open LetterWorks™ and type in the word Cappuccino.
3. Change the font to Conservative and resize to 3/4" x 3 1/4".
4. Save the design, and exit LetterWorks™.
5. Repeat the process, type in the word Mocha using the sponge font and size it to approximately 3/4" x 2".
6. Save the design and exit and return to LetterWorks™ for the next corner.

7. The Lower left corner will be Latte in the Regal script font and resize to ¾” x 2”. Save the design.
8. The Lower right corner will be Espresso in Finesse font and at a size of ¾” x 2 ¾”. Save and exit.
9. Save the corner words to a floppy or write them to a card for use with the machine.
10. Secure the stabilizer in the hoop and adhere a corner of the placemat, embroider the coffee names on each corner.
11. Repeat the embroidery process for the second placemat.

For the Framed Wall Art:

1. Open Designer’s Gallery® and Type in the words Coffee House using the classic script and size it to be about 9 ½” long.
 2. Click and drag on the purple dots selecting the center top of the design and the center bottom of the design, manipulating the center of the design to be taller than the ends.
 3. Move above the words Coffee House select the text tool again and right click.
 4. Select monogram from the menu.
 5. On the monogram properties screen, select the design monogram, change the letters to CH, and select the fourth décor choice and apply.
 6. Center the monogram over the words Coffee House.
 7. Select the text tool again and double click on the screen, “my text” will appear on screen. With this selected right click and choose circle frame.
 8. A circle frame will appear, center the frame over the existing Coffee House elements.
- Note: You can enlarge or reduce a circle frame by clicking on the dots on the frame and dragging them.
9. On the properties menu change the wording from “my text” to Cappuccino with a font style of conservative and a size of .39 inches.
 10. Rotate the circle design to the left.
 11. Repeat this process typing in Mocha in the Sponge font and rotate the circle to the right aligning the circle with the previous word.
 12. Repeat this process twice more, typing in Latte in the Regal script font. Then Espresso in Finesse font. Make sure you choose inverse selection on the properties screen for both of these, so the text will appear at the bottom of your circle.
 13. At the bottom of the screen are color squares representing each of the words. Select the first square and change the color to dark brown.
 14. Change the third color and last color to light brown.
 15. Change the fourth and fifth color to beige.
 16. Save the design and exit LetterWorks™.

17. Select the design and go to ColorWorks®, insert a color stop between the letters of the monogram and the décor outline.
18. Change the monograms letters to dark brown, and the outline to light brown.
19. Save the design and exit.
20. Drag and drop the design into the same location as the previous designs.
21. Save the design to a floppy or write it to a card for use with the machine.
22. Hoop the linen fabric and cut-away stabilizer in the 6.25” x 10.25” hoop and embroider.
23. When it has finished embroidering, remove from the hoop and lightly press.
24. Frame your Coffee House design and enjoy!

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
