Supplies:

Baby Lock® sewing and embroidery machine
Interactives™ Dining in Lace by Designer's Gallery® (Installed)
Embroidery thread
Baby Lock® Dissolve-Away Mesh stabilizer

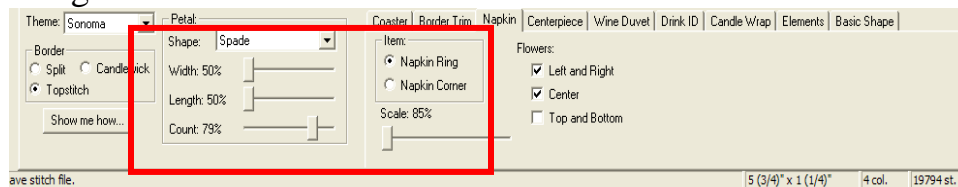
Instructions:

At the Computer:

1. Double click on the Interactives icon  on the desk top.



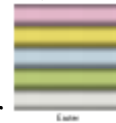
2. To open the program, select the Dining in Lace icon located to the left of the workspace.
3. On the command panel located at the bottom of the workspace, click on the tab labeled Napkin.
4. Next to Theme, click on the down arrow and choose Sonoma.
5. Set the Petal Shape to Spade.
6. Set the slide bars to the same location as shown in the illustration below.
7. Under the Flowers heading, place checkmarks next to Left and Right and Center fields. This will place three decorations on the top of the design.



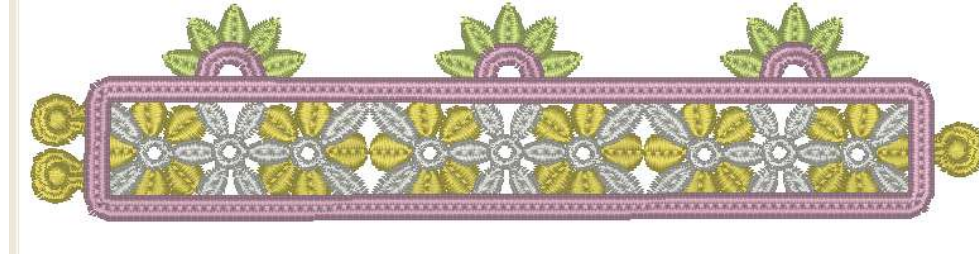
8. In order to change the colors in the design to pastels, select the Colors




icon on the top toolbar. Click on the Easter



option on the left toolbar. Slide the scroll bar slowly to change the colors in the design. Stop sliding when you have achieved the desired colors.



9. The design is ready to be saved. Click on the Save  icon. Give your design the name Easter Egg Holder. Choose the file format that your machine will read and save to the media source that your machine needs in order to read the design.

Embroidery:

1. Hoop the Baby Lock® Dissolve-Away Mesh stabilizer in the 5 x 7 hoop.
2. Bring the design into your embroidery machine.
3. Embroider the design using spring colored embroidery thread.
4. Remove the hoop from the machine.

5. Cut away excess stabilizer from the design.
6. Using warm water, gently rinse away the stabilizer until it is completely removed.
7. Lay on a flat surface to dry.
8. Use the tabs on each end to connect the egg holder.
